Chibardun Telephone and CTC Telcom maintains the highest standards of ethical conduct in all its marketing activities and is committed to complying with all federal and state law.

No employee or agent of Chibardun Telephone or CTC Telcom shall engage in telemarketing practices that violate the provisions of the Telephone Consumer Protection Act of 1991, the FTC Telephone Sales Rule, or applicable state regulations. In performing its duties under these requirements, Chibardun Telephone/CTC Telcom provides a written copy of this Do Not Call Policy to all personnel or entities that make calls for telemarketing purposes on our behalf. In addi-

tion, we also provide training to all our business office personnel and any personnel engaged in any aspect of telemarketing on our behalf, to ensure that they are informed and knowledgeable in regard to the existence, use and maintenance of our "Do Not Call" list.

If you don't want to receive sales calls from Chibardun Telephone/CTC Telcom, you can ask us to place your telephone number on the Chibardun Telephone/CTC Telcom "Do Not Call" list. In compliance with federal and state laws, upon your request, we'll make a record in our files that you contacted us and we will immediately add your number to our "Do Not Call" list. Please allow up to 30 days for your telephone number to be removed from any sales programs that may be currently underway.

You should include your name, address and telephone number in your request. If you have multiple telephone numbers, please tell us all numbers that you want included on the "Do Not Call" list.



Resolutions Procedure

As announced at the 2001 Annual Meeting in April 2002, Chibardun Telephone has adopted a new Resolutions Procedure. Due to the fact that written copies of all resolutions must be provided to the membership before they are presented to that body for action, the following procedures must be followed if a member wishes to have a resolution considered.

Any proposed resolution must be filed with the Resolutions Committee at least 90 days prior to the membership meeting (Annual Meeting) at which the resolution is to be considered and must be accompanied by a written report explaining the resolution. The resolution and explanatory report together shall not exceed a total of 1,000 words. Proposed resolutions should be submitted to the Resolutions Committee, Chibardun Telephone Cooperative, P.O. Box 664, Cameron, WI 54822. The date of the 2006 Annual Meeting is April 14, 2007.
